



How Will My/Our E3 Contribution Be Used?

A sampling of the measurable difference your contribution will make

- **\$50-\$500** - Provides for weekly updates to the E3 network about progress in environmental and sustainability education across the state.
- **\$1,000** - Facilitates technical support for E3 regional and sector leaders to update the E3 website with calendar events, updates, reports and other resources.
- **\$7,500** - Completes a linked calendar between regions, sectors and the state E3 master calendar of events and programs.
- **\$10,000** - Helps implement one component of the education “infrastructure” identified by E3 such as engaging teachers to provide environmental and sustainability education, assisting educators to give lessons on tribal history, making sustainability studies a college requirement and providing “green trades” in career and technical education programs.
- **\$12,500** - Builds the “E3 and Me” interactive action plan tool on the E3 website to promote individual actions for reducing carbon foot prints, making healthy choices and taking steps to help create a system of education for sustainable communities.
- **\$20,000** - Matches the commitment of the Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction to create, maintain and promote a section of the E3 website for student projects.
- **\$40,000** - Underwrites annual statewide E3 summits and regional gatherings at which members of the E3 network can exchange ideas and coordinate to pursue network-wide strategic priorities.
- **\$60,000** - Results in the design of web tools and training sessions for E3 state, regional and sector leaders to implement, track, evaluate, and make necessary adjustments while developing and managing a system of education for sustainable communities.
